Bill to Approve the Fall 2018 Allocations

Whereas, the Rutgers University Student Assembly (RUSA) is dedicated to providing a means for and promoting student involvement and awareness within the University and the community at large; and

Whereas, the RUSA Allocations Board is responsible for the allocation of funds to registered Rutgers University Student Organizations as well as various registered events on an as needed basis; with a goal to promote and support diversity of programming made available to all Rutgers University Students through the fair and efficient use of the student activity fee; and

Whereas, the goal of the RUSA Allocations Board is to promote and support diversity of programming made available to all Rutgers University Students through the fair and efficient use of the student activity fee; and

Whereas, the Fall 2018 Budget Requests for recognized RUSA organizations for the 2018-2019 academic year were due on Thursday, March 29th, 2018 for on-time submissions; and

Whereas, on Friday, April 6th, the RUSA Allocations Board met from 5:00PM to 10:00PM, Saturday, April 7th, from 11:00AM to 10:00PM, and Sunday, April 8th, from 11:00AM to 2:00PM to decide the allocation of \$616,109 to 328 organizations of the Rutgers University New Brunswick/Piscataway Campus; and

Whereas, in order for groups and organizations to effectively program events, the RUSA constitution requires the approval of the RUSA body to approve the Fall 2018 allocations for the groups listed in the spreadsheet attached; therefore

Be it Hereby Enacted, that RUSA approves the Fall 2018 allocations for those registered student groups that applied by the due dates; and

Be it Hereby Resolved, that RUSA approves the allocation of a total of \$616,109 to 328 registered student groups and organizations at Rutgers University New Brunswick/Piscataway Campus using the School Fee.
