Bill to Ensure that Student Organizations are Not Precluded from Allocations Under the Funding Guidelines, Section 1(A)(7)

Whereas, the Rutgers University Student Assembly (RUSA) previously enacted changes to RUSA’s Guidelines for Funding which could not be successfully implemented,

Whereas, the Assembly, through allocating RUSA’s portion of the Student Activities Fee, promotes a rich and diverse array of student organizations which contribute greatly to the student experience on the Rutgers University — New Brunswick campus, and

Whereas, the Assembly has the ability to amend the Guidelines for Funding, but must do so a semester prior to their implementation, in accordance with the Standing Rules, therefore:

Be it hereby resolved by two-thirds of RUSA that the Guidelines for Funding are amended, in accordance with Article 18, Section 4 of the Assembly’s Standing Rules, to strike Section 7 within (I)(A), and its corresponding footnote, and to replace the aforesaid section with an emboldened and italicized “***Removed.***”

Be it further resolved that the Director of RUSA’s Sexual Violence Education Department, or successor office or unit, be charged with the following task and report back to the Assembly upon a complete and thorough inquiry by January 24th, 2019:

Investigate substitutes or alternatives to the Bystander Intervention Training program offered through Rutgers VPVA that would be best able to be distributed to the leaders of student organizations which receive their funding from the RUSA Allocations Board.
